- (ili) that such scholars shall be exempted from paying tuition fees.
- The University shall award medals to all candidates securing the First position in order of merit at the Bachelor's degree or Master's degree examination of the University in all the courses. In adjudging places of merit, results of supplementary examinations shall not be taken into consideration.
- 10. The following shall be the rules for award of all medals:
 - that only the regular students shall be eligible for the award of any medal;
 - that the University medal for standing First in order of merit shall be awarded to the candidate who has been placed in the First Class;
 - (iii) that notwithstanding the provisions made in clause (i) of this ordinance, teachers and teacher-trainees who are candidates for the Master's degree in Engineering/Technology shall be eligible for the award of medals for standing First provided they have passed the examination in not more than three consecutive academic years not having failed to pass in any of their Master of Engineering/Technology examinations:
 - Provided that to qualify for these medals one has to pass in Part-I and/or Final Examination in the regular course and in case the candidate securing the highest marks in a particular subject, for which a medal is awarded, is not regular, the medal shall be awarded to the next candidate.
 - "Regular student" shall mean a student who is not enrolled as a casual student or a student who is not a repeater in the same class.

11. (a) UNIVERSITY MEDALS

List of Medals/ Prizes etc. The University awards medals to the students standing First in First Class in the Post-graduate and the Undergraduate courses in respective subject in the different Faculties in accordance with the prescribed rules of the University.
