About Davangere University

Davangere University is one of the growing universities in Karnataka. It has a jurisdiction of two districts. Davangere and Chitradurga, and headquartered at Shivagangotri, Davangere. Shivagangotri is located at about 10 Kms from Davangere. It is very close to Tholahunse railway station. Davangere University was established on 18th August 2009 with a vision to meet the education aspiration of the people of this region. The University has 120 college affiliated to it and one constitute college offering Graduate and Post Graduate Programmes in various disciplines catering to the needs of more than 70,000 students.

About the Seminar

Relevance of BabuJagjivan Ram:

BabuJagjivanRam is multifaceted and phenomenal Indian leader. Born in a humble family in Chandwa in Bihar, he rose to the position of Deputy Prime Minister of India. He has contributed to social, political and economic reforms in India. He reacted against the social (communal) discrimination at the very age of 12 in Aggrawal Middle School in Arrah by breaking the tradition of keeping drinking water in separate pots for the Hindus, the Muslims and the Untouchables. He continued his protest against the social discrimination in Banaras Hindu University where the students of scheduled caste were denied the basic services like meals in the hostels and haircut by the local barbers. He quite BHU in order to protest against the social discrimination and continued his education in Calcutta University. He political career was founded on his concern for social justice and was instrumental for the establishment of All India Depressed League in 1935. When he was elected to Bihar Legislative assembly in 1937, he took the cause of the social reform by organizing Rural Labour Movement. Though BabuJagjivan Ram was first noticed by

Subhash Chandra Bose as a struggler in the Mazdoor Rally at Wellington Square in 1928, he associated himself with the Indian Freedom Movement led by Mahatma Gandhi who he accepted and followed as leader and role model throughout life. He participated actively in Satyagraha Movement and quit India movement. He was elected a member of the Constituent Assembly and is said to have advocated for the rights of the Depressed sections in India. He has served in the Indian Union cabinets as Labour Minister, Communications Minister, Railways Minister, Transport Minister, Labour, Employment & Rehabilitation Minister, food & Agriculture Minister, Defence Minister and Agriculture & Irrigation Minister. He was Member of Parliament for forty years. He was a member of Indian National Congress for four decades. He was Deputy Prime minister during 1977-79. He founded his own party called Congress(J). He was responsible for the economic reform through several policies during his tenure as Minister of various portfolios.
