


Call for Papers

The Department of Sociology, Jadavpur University is inviting original manuscripts in the form of articles and book reviews for publishing in the forthcoming edition of its annual peer-reviewed journal, the *Jadavpur University Journal of Sociology* (ISBN 0976-5212).

The last date for submission of manuscripts is 15-02-2019. All submissions are to be sent to the email address – jujournalofsociology@gmail.com.

Guidelines For Research Articles:

1. All manuscripts should be written in the MS-Word format with word limit not exceeding 5000 words. The manuscripts must be typed on one side of the paper, double-spaced, with wide margins on all four sides. The font should be in Times New Roman in 12 points. An abstract of 100-200 words must accompany each manuscript along with keywords.
2. The title page should comprise of the title of the paper, name(s) of the contributor(s), name of the institution the contributor is associated with, designation, official address with phone number and email address to which all correspondence regarding manuscript should be directed.
3. Within the text, contributors should adopt the author-date method of citation with page numbers mentioned after a colon. For example, Ferreira 2014 : 307.
4. All bibliographic details should be cited under the heading References. References must be listed in an alphabetical order beginning with the last name of the (first) author. In case of articles, mention the name(s) of the author(s) followed by the year of publication, title of the article within single inverted commas, name of the journal in italicized fonts, volume and issue number and page numbers. In case of chapters in edited works, mention the name(s) of the author(s), the year of publication, the title of the chapter within single inverted commas, the name(s) of the editor(s), title of the book in italicized font and page numbers. In case of books, the ideal sequence is the name(s) of the author(s), the year of publication, the title of the book in italicized font, the place of publication and the name of the publisher. In case of newspaper articles, the reference should begin with the name of the author followed by year and then date of publication, followed by title of the article, name of the newspaper in italics and finally page number(s). The reference list should include all articles cited in the text and tables.
5. Maps, graphs, drawings and other figures should not be larger than page size. They should be arranged and numbered as per their references in the text. All photographs and scanned images should have a resolution of minimum 300 dpi and 1500 pixels and their format should be TIFF or JPEG.



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6. For non-English and uncommon words and phrases, use italics throughout the text. Meaning of such words should be given in parenthesis after the word when used for the first time in the manuscript.
7. Notes should be numbered serially and presented at the end of the article.
8. Single quotes should be used throughout the text. Spellings of words within quotes should not be changed. Double quotation marks should be used within single quotes.
9. 'ibid' (roman with a lower case 'i') must be used in the main text.
10. Abbreviations are to be spelled out when being used for the first time within the text.

Guidelines For Book Reviews:

1. The title must contain the name(s) of the author(s), the name of the book that is being reviewed, the year of publication, the place of publication and name of the publisher, number of pages, price, binding (hardbound or paperback) and the ISBN number.
2. Reviewer's name must be provided at the end of the manuscript with affiliation and contact details of the reviewer.
